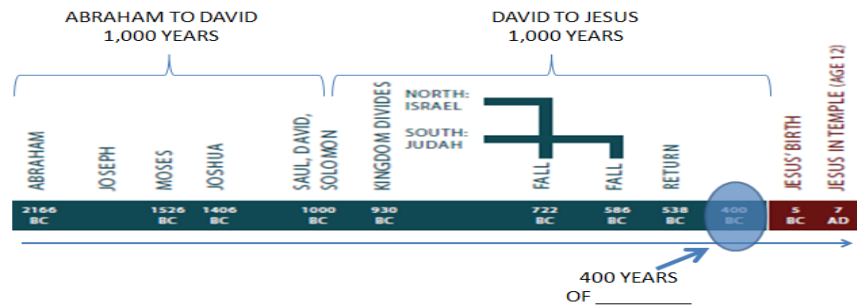


# Zachariah's Song

and the good news of what God saved me \_\_\_\_\_!*

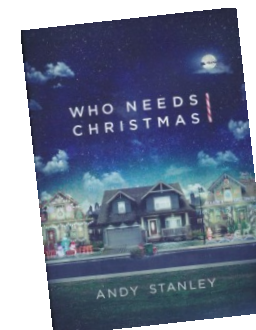
