**PRAY FOR OUR GLOBAL REACH PARTNERS REACHING THE LOST...**  
Frontier People Groups (FPGs) are Unreached People Groups with 0.1% or fewer Christians of any kind, and no evidence of a self-sustaining gospel movement. There are about 4,765 Frontier People Groups with total population 1,844,366,000. One fourth of the world lives in FPGs and have almost no chance of hearing about Jesus from someone in their own people group. two roads, two destinies...

We are all travelers through life. The Word of God makes clear that there are only two roads to travel to our destination. Jesus said:

"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it."  
- Matthew 7:13,14 NIV

There are only two ways - the way to life and the way to destruction. There are only two roads - the narrow and the broad. You're on one road or the other.

Jesus did not hide the road to heaven, or the path of salvation. In John 14:6 He said, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." Christ is the road to life. All who receive Him as Lord and Savior are on their way to heaven.

But the real fact is that not all are willing to enter the door or go by the way of the Cross of Christ. Many are trying out their own way of salvation. Isaiah 53:6 says: "We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way." Solomon adds in Proverbs 14:12: "There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death."

Believing in Jesus as the forgiver of your sin and the leader of your life is the gate and the way that leads to heaven and everlasting life. Rejecting Christ is the way that leads to death and hell. So, which road are you on?

Only Two Destinies

There are only two destinies for everyone. Eternity is waiting for all of us - we all will spend eternity somewhere. Heaven and hell are clearly set before us in the Bible as the destiny of the saved and unsaved respectively.

Jesus said, "In my Father's house are many rooms . . . I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am" (John 14:2,3).

To those who reject Him and will not go through the narrow gate Jesus warns, "How will you escape being condemned to hell?" (Matthew 13:49).

Hell will be a horrible place. Words fail to describe the remorse and miseries of hell. Likewise words fail to describe the beauty of heaven.

Choose the right road and the right destiny today. Put your faith this moment in Jesus - the crucified, risen, eternal Son of God. Receive Him as your Lord and Savior!
