two roads, two destinies...

We are all travelers through life. The Word of God makes clear that there are only two roads to travel to our destination. Jesus said:

"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it." - Matthew 7:13.14 NIV
